The power of information in Palestine

June 20th | 16:00H - 17:30H

Since the expulsion of Palestinians from their homes in 1948 and the advent of military occupation in 1967, the rights of the Palestinian population have been increasingly eroded. The relationship between the two sides has evolved over the years, passing from moments of "relative calm" to others of great intensity. Despite the different degrees of tension in different moments of time, reality shows that Palestinian's rights people have been steadily eroded and the possibilities to lead a dignified life forgotten.

The international community's response to this systematic violation of the most basic human rights has not been able to provide a stable solution to the problem, and the different negotiations that have begun have always ended in deadlock.

In this context, ensuring access to information and the ability of Palestinian journalists to communicate, is fundamental. Being a journalist, or an activist in Palestine is an issue that almost nothing is known about. What are their daily difficulties, how they live and how they report the daily reality, what are their objectives, what is the role of social activism, especially for the young population...

In this round table, we would like to propose a debate with the participation of Palestinian women communicators who will give us their points of view on the different aspects of this topic.

Palestine on the international stage

The occupation of Palestine by the Israeli government for more than five decades, as well as the attention that this has raised up in the international community, has gone through different stages, drawing the attention of the international media in different degrees. Nevertheless, the usual and most common narratives have not tended to deviate from the more traditional approach, which has meant that understanding the causes, consequences and power relations of the current situation and its prospects require a major effort in the so-called "information age".

Getting a complete picture, having heard the different voices and perspectives will allow us to understand the reality.

In this roundtable, we will analyze, from a wide perspective, topics traditionally made invisibles about the situation in Palestine. We have invited journalists' women who work or have worked in Palestine to share their challenges and difficulties to inform about what is happening in Palestine.
